



Co-Curricular Academic Enrichment Tutorials



The co-curricular academic enrichment tutorials provide consolidated learning opportunities across a range of subjects throughout the week and are supported by subject area professionals. While the tutorial program is largely optional, students may at times be requested to attend based on academic performance. These tutorials are free of charge. Times and days of tutorials may change on a term by term basis.

CURRICULUM

Before and After College Tutorials

English and Humanities Tutorials, Years 11-12

Tutorial sessions develop skills in senior English, Literature and HASS subjects, with a specific focus on understanding assessment and applying Instrument Specific Marking Guides. Students are provided with personalised assessment support, draft feedback and literacy reinforcement.

English Tutorials, Years 7-12

Students are provided with personalised assistance, as well as literacy reinforcement, reading comprehension and opportunity to work in small groups, developing skills. These skills align with the English units of work studied by students in Years 7-12.

Science Tutorials, Years 7-12

These tutorials aim to provide students with support to improve knowledge and understanding in Science as well as limited assistance with homework and advice with regards to assignments, exams and test preparation. Available for any Science student from Years 7 to 10 and Physics, Chemistry and Biology students in Years 11 and 12.

Maths, Years 9-12

These tutorials offer small group support and extension for all students that is aligned with the topics being studied in class.

Maths, Years 5-8

These tutorials aim to explicitly improve numeracy skills of students in the Middle College.

Chinese Tutorials (Senior Speakers' Club), Years 5 to 12

Students are provided with assistance for preparing assignments and gaining confidence in language competency. Students can seek assistance in developing their language learning skills, reading and understanding Mandarin texts.

Options Tutorials, Years 11-12

Students have access to Teachers for study and tutorial assistance during P4 and P5 on Wednesdays.

EXCEL Tutorials, Years 9-12

Students have access to Teachers for study and tutorial assistance during P5 on Fridays.
